



Play @ Work Photography Competition

Organised by Singapore Heart Foundation and The Photographic Society of Singapore

Rules & Regulations

1. This Play @ Work Photography Competition is jointly organised by the Singapore Heart Foundation and The Photographic Society of Singapore.

2. The theme of this Competition is ***Play @ Work (Workplace Wellness)***.

Participants must send in photo entries that showcase general fitness and wellness at work. This could include images of office workers exercising at the workplace, eating healthily at work, working in a healthy environment and so on. The list given here is only an example and is non-exhaustive. Participants are encouraged to be creative in interpreting the theme.

3. Submission deadline is **10am, 28 September 2009**. Winners will be notified by email and telephone.

4. The decision of the judges is final. No correspondence pertaining to the selection process will be entertained.

5. Entries will be judged on i) innovation and creativity, ii) image quality, iii) impact of photo, and iv) interpretation of the theme.

6. All subjects must be photographed in real environments. Avoid studio photography or a composition of studio and outdoor images. Do not use unnatural lighting effects.

7. This competition is open to all Singapore citizens and permanent residents.

8. Each Entrant may enter a maximum of five (5) entries which can be in colour or in black and white for either ONE of the categories; Open or Student category.

9. Each Entrant must register for this competition individually using the entry form available at www.myheart.org.sg. Hard copies of the entry form must be submitted together with the photo entries. No team entries are allowed.

10. Photographs that have won prizes in any photography competition, or have been used for commercial purposes, or been published will not be eligible for this competition.

11. All entries must be submitted in a CD or DVD (JPEG format). Each image must be at least 3000 pixels wide for a horizontal image or at least 3000 pixels tall for a vertical image.

12. Submit all entries to **Singapore Heart Foundation office, 9 Bishan Place, #07-01 Junction 8 (Office Tower) Singapore 579837**, on weekdays between 9am and 6pm. E-mail entries will **not** be entertained.

13. There must not be any significant removal or addition of elements in the image. Digital enhancement is allowed as long as it does not distort the reality of the image.

14. An image that combines the elements of more than one photograph is not eligible.

15. The organisers, Singapore Heart Foundation and The Photographic Society of Singapore, will not be liable for any loss of entries before or after the Competition.

16. By entering the Competition, the participant represents, acknowledges and warrants that every entry submitted is an original work created solely by the participant, that the entries do not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity and that no other party has any right, title, claim or interest in the photograph.

17. By submitting the photograph for the Competition, each participant who wins a prize grants the organisers without any charge, a perpetual, non-exclusive right, to publish, reproduce, display, distribute and create any derivative works of the photograph in any form or media in connection with the Competition and the promotion of the Competition or advertising and in any project undertaken by the organisers. In all cases where such photographs are used, the organisers reserve the right to do so without obtaining the further prior permission of the participant, and without offering any further compensation of any form. However, where any photograph is reproduced in print, the photographer will be credited.

18. Each participant who wins a prize warrants that he/she is the owner of the photograph (and all the intellectual property and other proprietary rights in the photograph submitted). The Entrant shall indemnify the organisers against all intellectual property infringement and other proprietary claims including any costs, charges and expenses in respect thereof.

19. Prizes

Open Category

1st Prize: \$1,000

2nd Prize: \$500

3rd Prize: \$250

Student Category

1st Prize: \$500

2nd Prize: \$300

3rd Prize: \$200

20. Prizes are in Singapore dollars and are non-transferable. If the quality of entries, in the opinion of the judges, is deemed not meeting the standards, the organisers reserve the right not to award a prize/prizes.

21. Winning entries of each category will be exhibited at World Heart Day 2009 held on 24th and 25th October 2009 at the open field beside Causeway Point.

22. Submission of entries indicates to the organisers that the participant has read and agreed with these Rules and Regulations of the competition.
