Heart foundation gets \$200k

MORE than \$200,000 was raised for the Singapore Heart Foundation (SHF) through a charity golf event last Friday.

The money came from the golfers who took part in the event, the 8th Singapore Heart Foundation-Isetan Foundation Heart Charity Golf tournament, as well as from sponsors and the public.

The sum raised - \$227,000 - was slightly less than last year's \$231,215.

More funds will come from the efforts of youth volunteers who are making an attempt to get into the Singapore Book of Records for the largest number of origami hearts folded.

The volunteers aim to fold about 38,000 of these paper hearts. They have so far hit the 20,000 mark, and will be plugging at this until November, raising a token amount of money from the golfers for each heart folded.

The youth come under the Citibank YMCA Youth for Causes, a joint community initiative by Citibank and the YMCA of Singapore sponsored by the Citi Foundation.

The SHF will use the funds to promote awareness of heart disease and stroke.
